Your participation will be highly valuable in enriching discussions and fostering regional cooperation. The **detailed program** for the conference is enclosed.

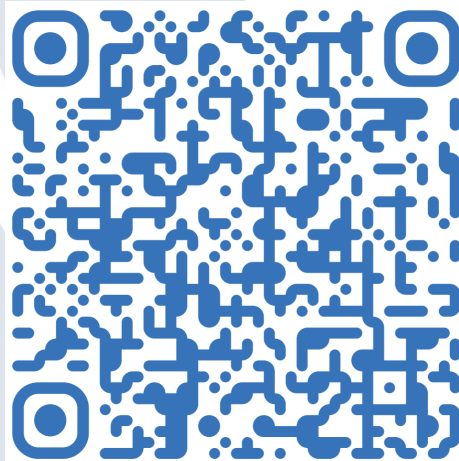
